#### TAR AWAY SUPER SOLVENT DEGREASER

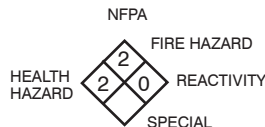
This fast acting solvent degreaser cuts through buildup of asphalt or heavy grease. Emulsifies tar, asphalt, grease and oil for removal from cars, engines, trucks, heavy equipment and other industrial parts. Washes off with water or solvent.

**DIRECTIONS:** Apply with sprayer or brush on. For floors, use mop and allow 5 minutes for penetration. Rinse with steam or water. May be diluted with up to 10 parts of water or aliphatic solvent for light duty applications. **DO NOT USE ON PLASTIC.**

**DANGER:** Combustible liquid. Causes skin and serious eye irritation. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways. Keep away from flames and hot surfaces. –No smoking. Wear protective gloves and eye protection. If on skin (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Rinse skin with water or shower. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice or attention. If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice or attention. If swallowed: Immediately call a poison center or doctor. Do NOT induce vomiting. In case of fire use dry chemical, foam, or carbon dioxide. Store in a well-ventilated place. Store locked up. Keep cool. Dispose of contents and container in accordance with local, state, and national regulations. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
